Technical Specs & Load Limits

Constructed from 1.5mm anodized aluminum, the TR500 TrailMaster Panniers boast a formidable structure designed to withstand the rigors of off-road adventures. Each pannier offers a generous carrying capacity, with the left side holding 37 liters and the right side accommodating 48 liters. The maximum load limit is 10 kg per pannier, ensuring safe and stable travel.

The panniers are rigorously tested to endure speeds up to 130 km/h, providing peace of mind during high-speed tours.

Step-by-Step Installation

Installing the TR500 TrailMaster Panniers is straightforward with the included mounting kit. Required tools include a torque wrench, Allen keys, and spanners. Begin by securing the mounting brackets to the bike's frame using bolts, adhering to the specific torque settings of 25 Nm. Next, attach the panniers to the brackets, ensuring the quick-release latch mechanism engages correctly.

Weatherproofing & Maintenance

The TR500 TrailMaster Panniers are built to withstand the harshest weather conditions, featuring IP67 waterproof sealing. Regular checks of the gasket seals are recommended to maintain optimal performance. For the aluminum finish, clean with a mild detergent and water, avoiding abrasive materials that could compromise the surface.

Lubricate the lock cylinders monthly with a silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.

Safety & Latch Operation

Our panniers are equipped with a robust keyed-alike quick-release system, offering both security and convenience. The locking mechanism is designed for easy one-handed operation, allowing swift access to your gear while maintaining safety.

Ensure the locking latches are fully engaged before setting off, and always double-check the security of the panniers after long rides or rough terrain to prevent accidental disengagement.
